## The "Little Apocalypse" of Jesus in the Synoptic Gospels

We have three versions of this "little apocalypse" of Jesus in Mark, Matthew, and Luke. Mark is our earliest gospel so the other two are *revising and commenting* upon Mark as the base text. It is important to compare all three side by side.
